USF envisions an urban Aboriginal community that is holistic, equitable and self-sufficient. The foundation's mission is to grant opportunities for Urban Aboriginal people on their journey to success through education and training, post secondary scholarships, and through the relief of poverty.

Urban Spirit Foundation's three core purposes are:

- To develop and deliver programs and services that provide education and training that enhance job and career opportunities for urban youth-at-risk (Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal).
- To provide post-secondary scholarships based on need and ability to persons of Aboriginal descent who are pursuing post-secondary studies in fields that will help meet the specific needs of First Nations, Inuit, or Métis peoples and communities in Canada.
- To relieve poverty among urban Aboriginal individuals and families by providing food hampers, clothing, bus passes, emergency funds and similar assistance in times of need.

USF Announces Educational Scholarships

These scholarships will be spread out through Metro Vancouver through the Native Education College, the Vancouver and Surrey school boards, and BCIT.
